Summer Day Camp (5 – 12 year olds)

Fun and exciting recreation summer day camp that will operate for 1 week sessions between June and August. Each week is truly unique, as campers enjoy a wide array of activities focused on special themes. Camp sessions provide supervised, structured activities, camp-wide events and/or field trips. Campers will enjoy great activities like sport skills, games, arts and crafts, nature activities, stories and social skill development. Campers are responsible for bringing their own sack lunch and snack. Youth in the program may travel to places in the Barnwell Community via Local Motion or may walk to parks close to Hagood Avenue Gym. For Field Trips outside of the Barnwell Community transportation will be provided by local school district buses.

Week 1: June 7– 11, 2010 We've Got Game

Week 8: July 26 – July 30 Water World

Week 9: August 2 – 6 Build or Break!

Summer Camp Policies

Partial Payment Plan

Parents/guardians may reserve a spot with a 50% non-refundable down payment for each summer camp week. Payment in full is due the Friday before the camp session is to begin.

Age Policy

The cutoff date for a camper's age is September 1, 2010

Multi-child Discount

Multiple child discount: \$10 discount per child per week after initial registrant

Waitlist Policy

In order to reserve a spot on the waitlist a registration form must be completed. There is no fee to be placed on the waitlist. If a spot becomes available the camper's parent/guardian that is at the top of waitlist will be contacted via telephone. The parent/guardian will have 24 hours from the time of contact to make payment in full for the desired camp. If payment has not been received in full, the camper's parent/guardian next on the waitlist will be contacted.
