DISCUSSION OF FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGETS-GENERAL FUND, WATER & SEWER FUND, HOSPITALITY TAX FUND, AND ACCOMMODATION TAX FUND

Interim City Administrator Tony Dicks and Clerk & Treasurer Kim Vargo reviewed the preliminary budget information for fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 for the General Fund, W&S Fund, Hospitality Tax Fund, and Accommodation Tax Fund. Anticipated revenues and expenses from the operation of the new tissue plant were included. There are no projected rate increases. The General Obligation Bond for the new fire station was paid off with Capital Project Sales Taxes, so the millage rate will decrease by 13 mills for the debt service payments. There was also a discussion of purchasing needed capital items in the current year budget.

Councilmember Claytor made a motion to enter into Executive Session for discussion on personnel salaries. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Kinlaw and unanimously approved.
