SECOND AND FINAL READING OF ORDINANCE 2025-03 "TO RAISE REVENUE AND ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BARNWELL, SOUTH CAROLINA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026"

Councilmember Claytor made a motion to read the ordinance by title only. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Kinlaw and unanimously approved. Administrator Dicks read the ordinance by title only. Mayor Pro Tem Kinlaw made a motion to approve the second and final reading of Ordinance 2025-03. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Davis and unanimously approved. There were no changes in the budget from the first reading. The budget includes a 13.0 mill decrease for the debt service for the fire station general obligation bond. The operating millage will remain at 84.1 mills for a total millage rate of 84.1. There are no increases in water, sewer, or garbage rates.
